LOCATION AND HOURS OF POLLING PLACE**

At the Spring Election to be held on April 1, 2025 in the City of South Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, the following polling place locations will be used for the wards indicated:

Locations: South Milwaukee Public Library, 1907 12th Avenue -District 1, Wards 1, 2, 3, 4; Divine Mercy Parish, 800 Marquette Avenue, District 2, Wards 5, 6, 7, 8; South Milwaukee City Administration Building 2424 15th Avenue District 3, Wards 9, 10, 11, 12; Grobschmidt Senior Center, 2424 15th Avenue District 4, Wards 13, 14, 15, 16; and Central Count Absentee Ballot Processing, 2424 15th Avenue, all Wards.

All polling places will be open at 7:00 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m. and are accessible to elderly and voters with disabilities. Central Count Absentee Ballot Processing will be open at 8:00 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m.

Notice of Meeting of the Local and Municipal Board of Canvassers (MBOC)

At the close of voting on Election Day, pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 19.84, the Election Inspectors will convene as a joint meeting of the Local Board of Canvassers and the MBOC for the purpose of conducting the local and municipal canvasses pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 7.51 and 7.53(1). This meeting will be open to the public pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 19.81-89.
