OF THE COMMON COUNCIL  
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee  
May 3, 2022

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Shelenske. On roll, all were present.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item number nine was deleted from the agenda by the Mayor.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the April 19, 2022 Common Council meeting; b) approval of the Financial Reports for the various funds for the period ending March 31, 2022; and d) approval of the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending April 30, 2022 in the amount of \$2,853,334.90. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich updated the Council on the South Milwaukee Earth Day event held on April 30, 2022. This city collected 21 TV's and 110 canned goods for Human Concerns.

Under Human Resources Committee, Navarro/Backes moved to accept Code Enforcement Inspector and Environmental Health Specialist David Krey's letter of resignation with an effective date of April 21, 2022. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Backes moved to adopt the CDL Training Requirements Policy. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Pieper/Bukowski moved to approve the application for bartender license for the 2021-2022 license period filed by Ann M. Lyons. On roll call, Pieper, Bukowski, Bartoshevich, Navarro and Maass voted aye, Backes, Clark and Briesemeister voted no. Motion passed 5 in favor, 3 opposed.

Pieper/Clark moved to deny the application for "Class B" Combination license filed by Euro Sport Café, LLD/Qazim Abasovski, Agent, for the premise at 213 N. Chicago Avenue. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister/Maass moved to approve the Plan Commission recommendation to authorize the preparation of an amendment to the Development Agreement with South Milwaukee Condo, LLC (aka: Heritage Reserve) to eliminate any requirement to build the 6-unit townhouse, together with associated provisions. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to receive and place on file the 2021 Police Department Annual Report. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich/Clark moved to accept the mayor's recommendations for appointments to the following committees: 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee: Nels Monson, Pattie Bergeson, John Bazan, Melissa Ellis, Brian Morrison, Richard Thinner and Caitlin Schmidt; Police and Fire Commission: Robert Weber to fill the unexpired term of Joseph Bukowski. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Water/Wastewater Commission, Maass/Briesemeister moved to authorize the proper city officials to purchase a 2021 Caterpillar 420 XE Backhoe Loader with Silenced Hammer and Plate Compactor in the amount of \$147,170. On roll, all voted aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Backes/Navarro moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:06 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
