

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COMMON COUNCIL
Regular Meeting

South Milwaukee
July 19, 2021

The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Brooks at 7:00 p.m. On roll, all were present except Clark who was excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no deletions to the agenda.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Backes moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the June 15, 2021 Common Council meeting; b) approval of the financial reports for the various funds for the period ending May 31, 2021; c) approval of the Schedule of Vouchers for the period ending June 30, 2021 in the amount of \$1,111,111.19; d) approval of extension of "Class A" liquor license for Mari Cucunato, Inc./Mari Cucunato, Agent, to include tasting on patio area for the premise at 905 Milwaukee Ave. for the 2021-2022 license period; e) approval of permit for consumption and possession of intoxicants on public sidewalks/streets for a 1 day event on August 28, 2021 filed by Brent Narlock (Snarley's) for a Celebration of Life and Autism Fundraiser; and f) approval of permit for consumption and possession of intoxicants on public sidewalks/streets for a 1 day event on July 24, 2021 filed by Van Eimeren Kolonkla Post #27 – American Legion/Shawn Arndt, Agent, for a pig roast, fundraiser. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the August 3, 2021 Common Council meeting has been cancelled due to holidays, events and vacations.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council of the upcoming events in the city: South Milwaukee Heritage Days with parade, car show and Lions Fest July 23 – July 25, 2021 and the South Milwaukee Police Department Community Night Out on August 4, 2021 from 5:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Under Human Resources Committee, Navarro/Backes moved to suspend the rules to allow for giving the first, second and third readings to amend Ordinance No. 2211 to fix and establish the amount of salaries, wages and certain benefits and allowances which shall be paid by the City of South Milwaukee to the Fire Lieutenants its first, second and third readings at this meeting. On roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried. Navarro/Backes moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2215 to amend Salary Ordinance No. 2211 to fix and establish the amount of salaries, wages and certain benefits and allowances which shall be paid by the City of South Milwaukee to the Fire Lieutenants and give it its first, second and third reading, and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Backes moved to accept Police Officer Kyle Stormoen's resignation effective July 6, 2021. All voted aye, motion carried.

Navarro/Backes moved to accept Code Enforcement Assistant Dwight Olson's letter of resignation effective July 28, 2021. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Legislation & Permits Committee, Briesemeister/Maass moved to approve an application for "Class B" Combination license filed by Thirsty's, LLC/Kim Iwinski, Agent, for the premise at 500 Madison Avenue, to include a beer garden, for the 2021-2022 license period. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Maass moved to approve the application for a "Class B" Combination license filed by South Side Indoor Soccer, LLC/Lucio Rodriguez, Agent, for the premise at 305 N. Chicago Avenue, for the 2021-2022 license period. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Maass moved for suspension of rule 2.11 to allow giving an ordinance to change the polling place for all wards in the 1st District in the City of South Milwaukee its first, second and third reading at this meeting. All voted aye, motion carried. Briesemeister/Maass moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2216 to change the polling place for all wards in District 1 in the City of South Milwaukee its first, second and third reading, adopt the ordinance and publish a summary in the official newspaper as required by law. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Maass moved to permit European Beer Gardens, LLC/James M. Moran, Agent, to operate the Class "B" Beer license at 1014-1020 Madison Avenue for special events on July 20, 2021 from 3:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. and July 22, 2021 from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. for Milwaukee Bucks watch parties. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister/Maass moved to give an ordinance to amend the zoning code of the City of South Milwaukee to create a Residential Planned Development District at 2300 10th Avenue its first reading. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister/Clark moved to adopt Resolution No. 21-11 to approve a Certified Survey Map for re-division of Parcel 2, CSM 6218. All voted aye, motion carried.

Briesemeister reminded the Council that the next Plan Commission meeting is scheduled for July 27, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

Under Miscellaneous Business, Maass/Briesemeister moved to authorize the Wastewater Superintendent to do all things necessary in connection with the State of Wisconsin Environmental Improvement fund application. All voted aye, motion carried.

Maass/Briesemeister moved to adopt Resolution No. 21-12 to authorize the Wastewater Superintendent to do all things necessary in connection with the State of Wisconsin Environmental Improvement fund application. All voted aye, motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Navarro/Bartoshevich moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:36 p.m. All voted aye, motion carried.
