The Regular Meeting of the Common Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Shelenske. On roll, all were present except Alderperson Bukowski who was excused.

The meeting was prefaced by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Under President of the Council, Bartoshevich/Clark moved to adopt the items in the consent agenda: a) approval of minutes from the September 6, 2022 Common Council meeting; b) letter summarizing the 2021 tax collections, and; c) appointment of David R. Volland to the Supplemental Pollworker list. All voted aye, motion carried.

Bartoshevich reminded the Council that the Finance Committee will review the proposed City of South Milwaukee 2023 Operating Budget on October 11, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers.

Under Human Resources Committee, Navarro/Backes moved to adopt the amended Fire Department Administrative Assistant position description. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Plan Commission, Briesemeister/Maass moved to give the first reading on a proposed ordinance to rezone properties at 2318 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 2410 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 2430 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 1001 Marquette Avenue and 1015 Marquette Avenue. All voted aye, motion carried.

Under Reports of the Mayor, Chief Jessup gave an update on the South Milwaukee Police Department Community Night Out. Great event, sold out most of the food and all of the raffle tickets. Walmart has been a great partner for the event.

Mayor Shelenske gave an update on the upcoming 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration Open Doors event. Twenty-one locations throughout the city were open to the public during the event.
