

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 6/03/19 – 6/09/19

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)



The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **347** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A citizen reported a suspicious individual who appeared to be attempting to open doors on houses in the area of 13th and Marshall Avenues on June 8th. Officers located a 29-year-old Milwaukee man walking near Cleveland Place and Marquette Avenues who matched the description given. The man stated he was in the area to renovate a house and was checking doors on random residences in an attempt to locate the house where he was to work. Officers spoke with witnesses who observed the man attempt to open doors on residences in the area and were able to obtain video evidence of his actions. He was arrested and issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

Officers were dispatched to a report of an individual threatening others in the 1100 Block of Marion Avenue on June 9th. Officers spoke with a 44-year-old South Milwaukee man who stated he was upset with noise occurring due to a recent construction project. Officers also spoke with witnesses who provided a video recording of the man shouting and making threats. He was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Disorderly Conduct.

VEHICLE THEFT

A 64-year-old South Milwaukee man reported his vehicle was taken from the 1200 Block of North Chicago Avenue on June 4th. The keys to the vehicle were also missing. The vehicle was located later in the day in the city of Milwaukee when a Milwaukee Police Department officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested a 33-year-old Milwaukee man for Operating While Intoxicated. The investigation into the vehicle theft is ongoing.

ARREST WARRANT

A 41-year-old Oak Creek man was arrested on two confirmed warrants with the Caledonia Police Department following a traffic stop on June 8th. The man was able to post the required bond amount on the warrants and he was released.

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for speeding in the 1800 Block of Drexel Boulevard on June 6th. The driver, a 46-year-old Franklin man, was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Glendale Police Department. He was arrested on the warrant and taken to the police station where he was turned over to Glendale Police Department officers.

DRUG POSSESSION

A 20-year-old Milwaukee man was issued citations for Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Operating Without a Valid License, and Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Insurance following a traffic stop near Nicholson and College Avenues on June 5th.
