

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *7/1/19 – 7/7/19*



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **333** calls for service.

OBSTRUCTING

Officers from the Oak Creek Police Department were involved in a pursuit with a truck that was later located parked and unoccupied in the 700 Block of Sycamore Avenue on July 5th. The vehicle was towed by the Oak Creek Police Department. Later in the day, the owner of the vehicle, a 33-year-old South Milwaukee man, reported the vehicle stolen. When confronted with the information regarding the Oak Creek investigation, the man began to provide evasive answers. He was cited for Obstructing and released while officers from the Oak Creek Police Department responded to the scene to continue their investigation.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINT

An officer observed a vehicle driving on Lake Drive near Park Avenue with a heavily damaged windshield on July 1st. The officer conducted a traffic stop and the driver, a 38-year-old Milwaukee man, did not have a driver's license and an open container of beer was observed in the vehicle. The man did not show signs of impairment and was issued citations for Operating Without a Valid License, Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Insurance, Failure to Wear a Seat Belt, and Possession of Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle. A 36-year-old Milwaukee woman, who was a passenger in the vehicle, was issued a citation for Possession of Marijuana.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed and swerving in the 100 Block of North Chicago Avenue on July 5th. An officer observed the vehicle leave a restaurant in the area at a high rate of speed and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 25-year-old Cudahy woman, showed signs of impairment. She was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense and Operating with a Prohibited Blood-Alcohol Content-2nd Offense. She was also issued a citation for Non-registration of Auto.

Officers were dispatched to a report of a male and female arguing in the 200 Block of 14th Avenue on July 2nd with the male subject reportedly leaving the area intoxicated in a truck. An officer located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop near 15th and Park Avenues. The driver, a 29-year-old South Milwaukee man, showed signs of impairment. He was arrested and issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The original argument was determined to be verbal in nature.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Officers were dispatched to a report of a disorderly subject throwing items and making threats in the 1200 Block of Marshall Avenue on July 4th. Upon arrival officers located an intoxicated 58-year old South Milwaukee man who was shouting profanities. Multiple witnesses stated the man was asked to leave the area after becoming disorderly and starting arguments. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after he sobered up.
