

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *12/9/19 – 12/15/19*



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **241** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On December 15th, officers were dispatched to the 600 Block of Michigan Avenue for a report of a person acting disorderly. Upon arrival, officers spoke with a 21-year-old South Milwaukee woman who stated an intoxicated 29-year-old South Milwaukee man was pounding on her door and threatening her. The woman showed officers a cellphone video of the altercation and the man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

On December 9th, officers were dispatched to the 200 Block of Lake Drive after callers reported a man sitting inside a parked vehicle had exposed himself indecently to them. A 20-year-old Milwaukee woman and a 52-year-old Milwaukee man both stated the individual exited the vehicle with his pants down and exposed himself. Officers spoke with the 62-year-old Milwaukee man who was inside the vehicle and he denied exposing himself but admitted to removing his pants because he was hot. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Lewd and Lascivious Behavior.

On December 13th, officers were dispatched to a report of a male and female arguing in the 1300 Block of Minnesota Avenue. Officers spoke with a 36-year-old South Milwaukee woman and a 34-year-old South Milwaukee man who were involved in an argument. The woman stated the man pulled her hair during the argument. He was arrested and taken to the police station before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a domestic violence related charge of Disorderly Conduct.

RETAIL THEFT

On December 11th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual who fled a store in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue after attempting to leave with a garbage can full of items that were not paid for. An officer on patrol observed a man matching the description given board a nearby Milwaukee County Transit bus. Officers entered the bus and spoke with a 54-year-old Milwaukee man who admitted to being inside the store. The man was on probation and a condition of his probation was that he have no contact with the store he had entered. He was arrested on the Probation Violation before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Retail Theft.

On December 13th, officers were dispatched to the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue after security personnel from a nearby store observed an individual conceal items from the store in an attempt to leave without paying for them. Officers spoke with a 46-year-old Cudahy woman and located numerous store items inside a shoulder bag she was carrying. The woman admitted to not having money to pay for the items and she was arrested and taken to the police station where she was issued a citation for Retail Theft.
