WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY [2/11/19 – 2/17/19**](#)**



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **244** calls for service.

THEFT

A 55 year old Greendale woman reported a jacket containing car keys and other items missing from a restroom in a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue just after 9 am on February 13th. Surveillance video showed a 39 year old Milwaukee woman leave the restroom immediately after the victim with a large lump under her own jacket and she was issued a citation for theft.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A 21 year old Racine man was arrested and issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct after officers were dispatched to a report of an individual panhandling outside a business in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue at 12:47 pm on February 14th. Employees of the business had asked the man to leave the area after customers complained and he refused. He was taken to the police station where he was issued a citation and released.

Dispatch received a 911 call at 10:22 pm on February 11th from an individual in the 3300 Block of Marina Road who was difficult to understand. Upon arrival, officers located a highly intoxicated 58 year old South Milwaukee woman who refused medical assistance and would not state why she called 911. After she became argumentative with officers, she was issued a citation for Misuse of 911.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle striking a parked truck in the 1400 Block of Milwaukee Avenue at 1:59 am on February 13th. Upon arrival, officers observed a 22 year Milwaukee man behind the wheel of the striking vehicle. The man exited the vehicle and showed signs of impairment. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued citations for **Operating While Intoxicated, Prohibited Blood-Alcohol Concentration, and Failure to Keep a Vehicle Under Control**. The man was later released to a sober responsible adult.

At 11:07 pm on February 16th, Officers were dispatched to a report of a suspicious person inside a business in the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue. The individual had parked his vehicle illegally and ran into the business where he was acting strangely. Upon arrival, officers located the individual, a 53 year old Racine man, behind the wheel of his illegally parked running vehicle. The man showed signs of impairment and admitted to using cocaine earlier in the evening. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for **Operating Under the Influence**.

Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle striking a residence in the 700 Block of Lakeview Avenue at 2:36 am on February 17th. Upon arrival, officers located a vehicle in the front lawn with several car parts scattered around. A 22 year old South Milwaukee man was also located on the scene with minor injuries and he admitted to driving the vehicle. The man showed signs of impairment and he was arrested after being taken to the hospital for treatment of his injuries. He was taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for **Operating While Intoxicated**.
