

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 10/5/20 – 10/18/20



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **390** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On October 11th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual recently banned from a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue threatening to harm employees of the business over the telephone. The individual continued to call the business while officers were present and officers spoke with the 36-year-old Milwaukee man via the telephone. The man repeated his threats to the officers and he was issued a citation for Unlawful Use of a Telephone. Officers remained in the area after the man hung up and no problems were observed at the business.

On October 8th, officers were dispatched to a restaurant in the 100 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of a female in a vehicle blocking the drive-thru lane and refusing to leave. Officers spoke with a 30-year-old Chilton woman who claimed she was owed a free meal as the result of an issue with a previous visit. Employees knew of no such arrangement and she was asked to leave. When advised the issue was a civil matter and she would need to leave, the woman began to shout profanities and she was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On October 12th, an officer monitoring traffic observed a vehicle proceed through the stop sign at 17th and Rawson Avenues without stopping. A traffic stop was initiated in the 1200 Block of Rawson Avenue and the driver, a 25-year-old Mount Pleasant woman, showed signs of impairment. She was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Operating While Intoxicated-Second Offense.

STOLEN VEHICLE RECOVERY

On October 11th, officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle driving recklessly near 7th and Madison Avenues. An officer located a vehicle matching the description parked in the 2400 Block of 5th Avenue that was listed as stolen through the Milwaukee Police Department. A 15-year-old South Milwaukee boy who walked to the vehicle and was in possession of the vehicle's keys was detained for the Milwaukee Police Department as they were notified of the recovery. The owners of the vehicle retrieved the vehicle from the scene.

On October 10th, a citizen reported an unfamiliar vehicle parked on private property in the 1600 Block of Manitoba Avenue. The vehicle was unoccupied and was listed as stolen through the Oak Creek Police Department earlier that morning. Officers from the Oak Creek Police Department responded and stood by while the owner retrieved the vehicle from the scene.

RETAIL THEFT

On October 8th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for items. Officers spoke with a 59-year old Cudahy woman who was being detained by store security. The woman was in possession of meat and energy drinks that were not paid for. She was arrested and issued a citation for Retail Theft. The woman was also issued a citation for Trespassing after being previously being banned from the business due to prior retail thefts.

On October 18th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for items. Officers spoke with a 25-year-old Brookfield man who was in possession of the non-paid for items. He was arrested and issued citations for Retail Theft and Trespassing after being previously banned from the business due to prior thefts. Hours later, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual attempting to leave a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue without paying for items. Officers encountered the same Brookfield man who was in possession of the non-paid for items. He was arrested again and issued a citation for Retail Theft-Second Offense.
