

# **SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

## **WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *11/2/20 – 11/15/20***

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **450** calls for service.

### **WEAPONS OFFENSE**

On November 8<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 1600 Block of Monroe Avenue after a 36-year-old South Milwaukee man reported an individual threatened him with a gun following a confrontation. Officers located the individual, a 19-year-old South Milwaukee man, in the 1600 Block of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue and a firearm was recovered. The man was arrested and charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Disorderly Conduct-Use of a Dangerous Weapon.

### **TRESPASS**

On November 7<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of suspicious activity near a school in the 700 Block of Marion Avenue. Officers located a 19-year-old South Milwaukee man, an 18-year-old South Milwaukee man, and a 15-year-old Cudahy boy on school property after hours. As officers were speaking with the individuals, the Cudahy boy began to shout profanities at the officers. The South Milwaukee men were warned and advised on trespassing and the Cudahy boy was arrested and issued citations for Trespassing, Resisting Arrest, and Possession of Tobacco Products by a Minor.

## **WARRANT ARREST**

**On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle driving erratically in the 1800 Block of Lakeview Avenue. Officers located the vehicle near Clark Court and Blakewood Avenue and initiated a traffic stop. The driver, a 43-year-old Oak Creek woman stated she and her passenger, a 41-year-old Oak Creek man, were lost. The woman did not show any signs of impairment but was found to have two confirmed felony warrants with the Waukesha County Sheriff's Department. She was arrested and turned over to Waukesha County Sheriff's deputies on the warrants.**

## **SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY**

**On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, several callers reported hearing loud popping noises near the 500 Block of Oak Street. Officers searching the area located four individuals walking on the bike path near Grant Park. One of the individuals was carrying a bag of fireworks. Two 21-year-old Milwaukee men, a 20-year-old Milwaukee man, and a 19-year-old Cudahy woman were all issued citations for Use of Fireworks in the Park and Violation of Park Hours. The Cudahy woman was also issued a citation for Resisting Arrest after she became uncooperative with officers.**

## **VEHICLE THEFT**

**On November 14<sup>th</sup>, a 52-year old Brookfield man reported his vehicle was stolen while he was delivering food in the 1500 Block of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue. As the man was delivering food an unknown individual drove off with his vehicle. The vehicle, a black 2017 Kia Forte with license plate 653HWJ, was last seen northbound on 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Rawson Avenue.
