

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 4/5/21 – 4/18/21

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)



The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **390** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On April 7th, the South Milwaukee Police Department investigated an incident in the 400 block of Bay Heights Road, involving three adults. An altercation took place and an Oak Creek man was threatened with a baseball bat. During the investigation, a baseball bat was located at the residence and the South Milwaukee man was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and a felony probation detainer. A woman was also arrested and both the South Milwaukee man and woman were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges.

WARRANT ARREST

On April 11th, officers were dispatched to the area of 17th and Manitowoc Avenues after a citizen reported an unfamiliar truck parked near their residence. Officers spoke with a 43-year-old St. Francis man who was an occupant of the truck. The man was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he was turned over to Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department deputies on the warrant.

RETAIL THEFT

On April 15th, officers were dispatched to the 100 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual attempting to sell stolen items. Officers spoke with a 31-year-old Cudahy man who was in possession of some electronics and clothing items. Some of the items had tags from a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue. Officers went to the business and found the man had taken the items without paying for them. The man was found to have been placed on probation for a prior retail theft case on April 14th. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Retail Theft.

DRUG INVESTIGATION

On April 12th, officers were dispatched to the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual who appeared to be passed out in a vehicle. Officers arrived and were able to wake up the occupant who was a 42-year-old South Milwaukee man. Drug paraphernalia was observed in the vehicle and the man was arrested. He was taken to the police station and issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On April 10th an officer on patrol observed a vehicle without taillights swerving in the roadway in the 1700 Block of Rawson Avenue. A traffic stop was initiated near Nicholson and Rawson Avenues. The driver, a 29-year-old Milwaukee man, showed signs of impairment. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense and Operating Without Tail Lamps. He was released to a sober, responsible adult.
