

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 9/6/21 – 9/19/21***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **491** calls for service.

### **ROBBERY**

On September 9<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of a male subject who had robbed a business after presenting a note demanding money. An investigation determined the male was the same individual arrested by the Racine Police Department the next day after being involved in two additional robberies in Racine and Caledonia. The man was identified as a 20-year-old South Milwaukee man and he admitted his involvement in the South Milwaukee robbery. He was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Robbery-Threat of Force. He is also facing charges of Armed Robbery and Resisting an Officer in Racine County and has felony warrants through Waukesha County. A 23-year-old Racine man was also arrested in connection with this case and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Robbery-Party to a Crime.

On September 15<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of a male subject who had robbed a business after brandishing a knife. The same individual was found to be involved in additional robberies in Milwaukee, Cudahy, and Caledonia. During one of the Caledonia robberies, an involved vehicle was identified and located in Caledonia and a 33-year-old Milwaukee man was taken into custody following a traffic stop by officers from the Caledonia Police Department and Racine County Sheriff's Office. Evidence from the South Milwaukee robbery was located in the vehicle. The man was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Armed Robbery. He faces additional robbery charges in Racine County.

## **BATTERY**

On September 12<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 600 Block of Milwaukee Avenue for a report of a female being struck by a male. Officers spoke with a 24-year-old South Milwaukee woman who stated she was struck by a 26-year-old South Milwaukee man. She also stated the man damaged some of her property. Officers located the man nearby and he was arrested. He was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Substantial Battery and Criminal Damage to Property.

## **WARRANT ARREST**

On September 12<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of individuals acting suspiciously inside a parked vehicle. Officers spoke with a 21-year-old Milwaukee man and a 24-year-old Milwaukee woman who were with the vehicle. The woman was found to have confirmed warrants with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office, and the Sheboygan County Sheriff's Office. Marijuana was also located in the vehicle. The woman was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the warrants and the man was arrested and issued a citation for Possession of Marijuana.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

On September 16<sup>th</sup>, a 48-year-old Franklin man requested officers standby at a property he owned in the 1800 Block of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue while he changed the locks. A 30-year-old South Milwaukee woman who lived at the property was with the owner and confirmed proper notice was given. A 38-year-old South Milwaukee man and a 29-year-old South Milwaukee man who were not on the lease refused to allow the owner entry to the property. Entry was eventually made and the men were arrested and issued citations for Disorderly Conduct. The 29-year-old man was also found to have a confirmed warrant with the Oak Creek Police Department. He was released after signing a personal recognizance bond on the warrant.

On September 18<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 1300 Block of Milwaukee Avenue for a report of an individual acting disorderly. Officers spoke with several witnesses who stated an intoxicated 27-year-old Greenfield man was involved in several arguments and refused to leave a nearby business when asked to do so. The man was arrested and taken to the police department where he was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct. He was released when he sobered up.
