

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *1/24/22 – 2/6/22*



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **412** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On January 30th, officers were dispatched to a business in the 1900 Block of 17th Avenue for a report of individuals being disorderly and throwing food. Officers spoke with several witnesses who stated three individuals who appeared to be intoxicated entered the business and began to argue with patrons inside. When asked to leave, one of the individuals struck a 40-year-old South Milwaukee woman and threw a plate of food. The three individuals left prior to the arrival of officers but were later identified as a 51-year-old Cudahy man, a 47-year-old South Milwaukee woman, and an 18-year-old South Milwaukee woman. The Cudahy man was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and the 18-year-old South Milwaukee woman was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Battery.

On January 27th, officers were dispatched to an open 911 call with sounds of an altercation in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue. Officers spoke with a 34-year-old South Milwaukee man who stated he approached a 40-year-old South Milwaukee man who was near his parked vehicle and an altercation ensued. During the altercation the 40-year-old man struck the 34-year-old man. Surveillance video showed the 40-year-old man attempting to enter the 34-year-old man's vehicle prior to being confronted. The 40-year-old man was arrested and issued citations for Disorderly Conduct, Battery, and Possession of Marijuana after marijuana was found during a search prior to the arrest.

RETAIL THEFT

On January 25th, officers were dispatched to a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual leaving the store without paying for items. Officers located a 37-year-old Milwaukee man nearby who matched the description given of the individual. Witnesses identified the man as the individual in the store and surveillance video showed him leaving without paying for the items in his possession. He was arrested and issued a citation for Retail Theft.

On January 27th, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual suspected of a prior retail theft concealing items in an attempt to not pay for them. Officers spoke with a 42-year-old South Milwaukee woman who admitted to concealing the items. She also admitted to the prior retail theft. She was arrested and issued a citation for Retail Theft.

DRUG INVESTIGATION

On February 3rd, an officer on patrol observed an occupied parked vehicle in the 1600 Block of Milwaukee Avenue in which the vehicle registration was suspended and listed to an owner with a revoked driving status. While officers spoke with the occupants, a 22-year-old Greendale man and an 18-year-old St. Augustine, Florida man, a strong odor of marijuana was present. The Florida man was found to be in possession of marijuana and other narcotics. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Possession of Marijuana and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Possession of Controlled Substance. He was released to a 48-year-old South Milwaukee man who posted bond at the police station.

VEHICLE THEFT

On February 1st, a 2020 Kia Optima was stolen from the 1300 Block of Madison Avenue and a 2021 Kia Forte was stolen from the 1300 Block of Monroe Avenue. Both vehicles were recovered in the city of Milwaukee by the Milwaukee Police Department. An investigation is ongoing in an attempt to identify and locate suspects.
