

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *5/2/22 – 5/15/22*

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)



The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **450** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On May 9th, officers were dispatched to a restaurant in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual causing a disturbance. Officers spoke with a 24-year-old Milwaukee man who stated a 26-year-old Milwaukee woman was being loud and profane and kicking the door of the restaurant. The woman came to the restaurant to confront the man over relationship issues. The man also claimed the woman damaged some of his property. She was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Disorderly Conduct.

On May 6th, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 500 Block of Milwaukee Avenue for a report of individuals arguing. Officers spoke with a 58-year-old South Milwaukee woman and a 67-year-old Franklin man who stated they were involved in an argument with a 43-year-old South Milwaukee woman and a 31-year-old Cudahy woman and the Cudahy woman tossed garbage cans around the yard before leaving the scene. The Cudahy woman was uncooperative when contacted and she was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct. All involved parties were advised to be civil with each other or avoid contact in the future.

On May 8th, officers were dispatched to a business in the 1300 Block of College Avenue for a report of an altercation arising from a minor vehicle accident. Officers spoke with a 47-year-old South Milwaukee man and a 44-year-old South Milwaukee woman who stated they accidentally struck the illegally parked vehicle of a 24-year-old Cudahy man as they were slowly backing up in the parking lot. The South Milwaukee couple left the area when the Cudahy man attempted to pull the woman from their vehicle and drove to a safer location to report the accident. The Cudahy man then entered the business and became involved in a heated argument with a 56-year-old Cudahy man. The 24-year-old Cudahy man was arrested and issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Operating After Suspension of his driver's license. He was also issued a citation for Possession of Marijuana after marijuana was located in his vehicle.

RETAIL THEFT

On May 2nd, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual attempting to leave the store without paying for food. Officers spoke with a 32-year-old Milwaukee man who was observed by store employees hiding a package of hamburger meat in his coat. The man admitted to taking the food without any intention of paying for it and he was issued a citation for Retail Theft.

WARANT ARREST

On May 15th, officers were dispatched to a business in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue for an occupied vehicle that was parked for over an hour. Officers located the vehicle with the occupants inside sleeping. They were awakened and identified as a 44-year-old Milwaukee woman and a 42-year-old Watertown man. No evidence of drug use or paraphernalia was present. The man was found to have a confirmed warrant with the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office for Failure to Appear regarding Child Support. He was arrested and turned over to Jefferson County deputies on the warrant.
