

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 1/23/23 – 2/5/23***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **454** calls for service.

### **NOISE COMPLAINT**

On January 27<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 2400 Block of Nicholson Avenue for a report of loud music and stomping noises coming from a residence. The resident, a 55-year-old South Milwaukee man who had previously been cited for Unnecessary Noise, admitted to making noise again and was arrested. He was taken to the police station and issued citations for Unnecessary Noise and Disorderly Conduct. Shortly after he was released officers were dispatched to a report of an individual loitering on the back porch and attempting to enter a residence in the 1500 Block of Menomonee Avenue. Officers located the 55-year-old man on the porch and he was arrested and issued another citation for Disorderly Conduct.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

On February 3<sup>rd</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual creating a disturbance at a residence in the 600 Block of Manistique Avenue. A 34-year-old South Milwaukee woman reported a 32-year-old Milwaukee man damaged property during an argument. Officers observed damaged property and spoke with the Milwaukee man who was intoxicated. The man was found to have a No Contact Order and absolute sobriety as conditions of bail from previous cases involving the woman. He was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. He was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence Related, Criminal Damage to Property, and Bail Jumping.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

On February 4<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual leaving a store without paying for alcohol. Officers located an individual matching the description given near North Chicago and Badger Avenues. The individual ran when approached by officers and was later apprehended in the 700 Block of Badger Avenue. He was identified as a 31-year-old Milwaukee man and was in possession of the unpaid for items from the store. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Retail Theft and Resisting/Obstructing.

## **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On January 29<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle accident in the 500 Block of Madison Avenue. Officers located a parked vehicle with the driver's door open and witnesses on scene stated the female driver struck two parked vehicles before leaving the vehicle on foot. Officers located the driver, a 36-year-old Oak Creek woman in the 700 Block of Madison Avenue. The woman showed signs of impairment and admitted to driving the vehicle. She was arrested and issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense, Operating With a Prohibited Blood-Alcohol Concentration, and Hit and Run-Unattended Vehicle. She was released to a sober, responsible adult.

On January 30<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the area of 5<sup>th</sup> and Williams Avenues for a report of a vehicle accident. Officers located a man standing next to a vehicle parked with significant front-end damage. The man, identified as a 39-year-old Oak Creek man, showed signs of impairment and admitted to driving and striking another vehicle that was ahead of him at a stop sign. The second vehicle was located a short distance away and the driver, a 37-year-old Milwaukee woman, stated her vehicle was struck from behind by the Oak Creek man's vehicle while stopped at the stop sign. The Oak Creek man was arrested and issued citations for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense, Operating With a Prohibited Blood-Alcohol Concentration, and Inattentive Driving. He was released to a sober, responsible adult.
