

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 5/29/23 – 6/11/23***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **540** calls for service.

### **MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT**

On June 7<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 600 Block of Madison Avenue for a report of a motor vehicle accident. Officers arriving on scene did not locate any vehicles. An officer located a 30-year-old Brown Deer man standing by a damaged vehicle in the 700 Block of Milwaukee Avenue. The man claimed the damage was old and he was not involved in an accident. A second damaged vehicle registered to the man was located parked in the 500 Block of Madison Avenue. The man then admitted to visiting a 26-year-old South Milwaukee woman who drives his second vehicle and as the two were leaving a nearby business, they accidentally crashed into each other. Officers spoke with the woman who denied driving the second vehicle. Surveillance video from the area showed the vehicles crashing into each other. The man was found to be on probation for Robbery and an order to detain was received from Probation and Parole. The man was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the probation hold. He was issued citations for Obstructing and Hit and Run. The woman was issued citations for Obstructing, Hit and Run, and Operating After Revocation.

### **BATTERY**

On May 29<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 1200 Block of Monroe Avenue for a report of individuals arguing. Officers spoke with a 20-year-old Caledonia man, a 24-year-old South Milwaukee woman, and a 25-year-old South Milwaukee woman. During the argument, the 24-year-old woman struck the 25-year-old woman. She was issued a citation for Battery.

## **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, officers were dispatched to a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual bothering customers and refusing to leave. Officers made contact with a 43-year-old man who was lying down outside the business. Multiple witnesses reported the man was acting indecently and refused to leave when asked to do so. The man admitted to placing his hands down his pants during his interactions with the witnesses. He was arrested and issued a citation for Lewd and Lascivious Behavior.

## **RETAIL THEFT**

On June 4<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue without paying for items. Officers located a 53-year-old Milwaukee man behind a dumpster in the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue who matched the description given. The man admitted to taking the items from the business. The man was in possession of other items that he admitted to taking from three other businesses in the area. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on four charges of Retail Theft.

On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual leaving without paying for items. Officers spoke with an 18-year-old Milwaukee man who was being detained by store security. The man admitted to taking items from the store without paying for them. He was arrested and issued a citation for Retail Theft.

## **DRUG INVESTIGATION**

On June 4<sup>th</sup>, an officer on patrol noticed a vehicle driving with a defective taillight and a traffic stop was initiated near the Oak Creek Parkway and North Chicago Avenue. The driver, a 35-year-old South Milwaukee woman, was found to have a confirmed felony warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Child Neglect. She was arrested and officers located marijuana, heroin, and fentanyl in the vehicle. The woman was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the warrant and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Heroin, Possession of Fentanyl, and Bail Jumping.
