

# ***SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT***

## ***WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 11/27/23 – 12/11/23***



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **425** calls for service.

### **HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT**

On December 10<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a business in the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of a hit and run accident. Officers spoke with a 29-year-old Oak Creek woman who stated a vehicle backed out of a parking stall and struck her vehicle. She further stated the driver of the striking vehicle got out but then left the area without providing information. Officers located the vehicle parked in the 400 Block of Bay Heights Drive and the registered owner, a 30-year-old Oak Creek man, matched the description given. Officers located the man at a nearby residence and he admitted to being at the business and speaking with the Oak Creek woman. He was issued a citation for Hit and Run.

### **DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

On December 11<sup>th</sup>, a 19-year-old Cudahy woman came to the police station to report being threatened by a 34-year-old South Milwaukee man. The woman stated the man followed her to the police station and damaged her vehicle while in the lot prior to leaving the area. Surveillance video showed the man damaging the woman's vehicle. He was arrested at his residence in the 400 Block of Southtowne Drive and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. He was charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence Related.

**On November 29<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 2900 Block of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue for a report of an individual kicking a door. Officers located a 40-year-old South Milwaukee man outside the residence and observed damage to the door. A 32-year-old South Milwaukee woman at the residence had a confirmed restraining order against the man. The man became uncooperative and was arrested. He was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility and charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Knowingly Violating a Domestic Abuse Injunction, Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence Related, and Criminal Damage to Property.**

**On December 3<sup>rd</sup>, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of a man screaming at customers. Officers located a 57-year-old Milwaukee man who was yelling loudly and acting disorderly. The business had to prevent customers from entering or leaving the store due to the man's actions. Employees also stated the man was asked to leave the store earlier after he was found to have been panhandling and had urinated on an outside wall of the store. The man was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.**

## **DRUG INVESTIGATION**

**On December 7<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to the 800 Block of Minnesota Avenue for a report of an responsive individual inside a running parked vehicle. Officers located the vehicle running with a man inside who appeared to be passed out. Officers woke the man up and he was identified as a 45-year-old Cudahy man. Drug paraphernalia, prescription medication, and heroin were located in the vehicle. The man was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. He was referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Possession of Heroin and Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Deliver.**
