

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 2/19/24 – 3/3/24

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)



The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **426** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On February 26th, officers were dispatched to a restaurant in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual causing a disturbance. Officers spoke with employees who stated a 45-year-old Milwaukee man took a sandwich from a child and threw it on the floor. The man then took a bag of chips off a shelf and ate them without paying for them. He then began to shout at employees when told to leave. Officers spoke with the man who admitted to throwing the sandwich. He was found to have an un-extraditable warrant through Illinois for Aggravated Assault. He was arrested and issued citations for Retail Theft and Disorderly Conduct.

On March 3rd, officers were dispatched to a restaurant in the 2700 Block of South Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual who did not purchase anything and was not leaving. Officers located a man sleeping inside the restaurant who originally provided false identification. The man was eventually identified as a 47-year-old Crandon man and was found to have a confirmed felony warrant with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. He was arrested and issued a citation for Obstructing before being taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility on the warrant.

ARREST WARRANT

On February 28th, officers were dispatched to the 500 Block of Southtowne Drive to assist with a child custody issue. While on scene, officers spoke with a 28-year-old South Milwaukee man who was found to have two confirmed warrants with the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office for Operating While Intoxicated and Bail Jumping. The man also had a confirmed warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Operating While Intoxicated. He was arrested on the warrants and turned over to deputies from the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office.

RETAIL THEFT

On March 2nd, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 Block of North Chicago Avenue for a report of an individual leaving the store without paying for items. Officers spoke with a 54-year-old Milwaukee man who was observed by store security placing un-scanned items in a bag and leaving without paying for them. The man originally provided false identification information and eventually admitted to taking the items. He was arrested and issued citations for Retail Theft and Obstructing.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

On February 25th , an officer on patrol conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle operating without headlights and taillights near 15th and College Avenues. The driver, a 27-year-old Beach Park, Illinois man, showed signs of impairment. Intoxicants were also located in the vehicle. He was arrested and issued a citation for Operating While Intoxicated-First Offense. He was released to a sober and responsible adult.
