

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 4/1/19 – 4/7/19



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **260** calls for service.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A woman reported a man indecently exposed himself to her in the 200 Block of Lake Drive before leaving the area in a white van on April 4th. Officers located the van in the 1000 Block of Milwaukee Avenue and initiated a traffic stop. The driver, a 39 year old Cudahy man, was arrested and issued a citation for Lewd and Lascivious Behavior based on statements given to officers at the time of the stop.

A citizen reported observing a man place several large rocks in the roadway in the 500 Block of North Chicago Avenue on April 7th. Upon arrival, officers located the rocks in the southbound traffic lane and a 30 year old South Milwaukee man cursing at passing vehicles. The man was positively identified by the caller and he was arrested and issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct. The rocks were removed from the roadway by officers.

Officers were dispatched to a report of a man threatening customers and refusing to leave a business in the 1600 Block of Monroe Avenue on April 3rd. Upon arrival, officers found several people holding an intoxicated 39 year old South Milwaukee man on the ground. Once separated, the man continued to shout and threaten individuals on the scene. He was arrested and taken to the police station where he was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

Officers from the Cudahy Police Department referred individuals to South Milwaukee Police who stated a 20 year old South Milwaukee man threatened a 16 year old South Milwaukee girl with a knife at a residence in the 500 Block of Southtowne Place on April 2nd. The man was later located at a residence in the city of St. Francis where he was arrested. He was taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility and later charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Recklessly Endangering Safety.

OPERATING UNDER THE INFLUENCE

Officers were dispatched to a report of a vehicle crashing into a tree in the 1300 Block of Marion Avenue on April 7th. The driver, a 26 year old Racine man, refused medical attention and admitted to smoking marijuana before the crash. His passenger, a 31 year old Mount Pleasant woman, was transported to the hospital by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel for multiple injuries. The Racine man was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of Operating Under The Influence-Causing Injury.

WARRANT ARREST

Officers were dispatched to Grant Park to assist a Wisconsin DNR Conservation Warden with a wanted individual on April 4th. While checking fishing licenses, the Warden discovered a 29 year old Greenfield man was wanted on a confirmed warrant with the Bibb County Sheriff's Office in the state of Georgia. The Greenfield man was arrested on the warrant and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility to await extradition to Georgia.
