

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY 4/20/20 – 5/3/20



(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)

The past two weeks the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **247** calls for service.

DRUG INVESTIGATION

On April 24th, officers were dispatched to a report of a man yelling in the street in the 1500 Block of Rawson Avenue. Officers located a 19-year-old Oak Creek man who was uncooperative and appeared to be under the influence of an illegal substance. The man was arrested and South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel responded to the scene. He was taken to the hospital where it was determined he had consumed an illegal psychedelic drug. He was issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting Arrest. It was determined the man consumed the drug at a residence in the 1500 Block of Rawson Avenue and officers went there and spoke with a 21-year-old South Milwaukee man. Drug paraphernalia was located at the residence and the South Milwaukee man was issued a citation for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On May 1st, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual pounding on the walls inside a restroom at a business in the 2300 Block of 10th Avenue. Officers located a 29-year-old South Milwaukee man in the restroom consuming illegal drugs. Drug paraphernalia was also located. The drugs were confiscated and the man was taken to the hospital by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel. He was issued a citation or Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on charges of possession of Fentanyl and Amphetamines.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

On April 26th, officers were dispatched to the 300 Block of Southtowne Drive for a report of an altercation between a male and a female. Upon arrival, officers located an individual later identified as a 22-year-old South Milwaukee man attempting to leave the scene in a vehicle. The man ignored officer's orders to stop and fled the scene, striking a nearby mailbox in the process. Other officers attempted to stop the vehicle but were unsuccessful. A 20-year-old South Milwaukee woman at the scene stated the man was a known acquaintance and had shoved her during an argument. A felony warrant was issued for the man and the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office issued charges of Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence Related, Fleeing or Eluding an Officer.

RETAIL THEFT

On April 27th, officers were dispatched to a report of an individual leaving a business in the 2900 Block of South Chicago Avenue with bottles of liquor that were not paid for. Security personnel followed the subject who dropped the bottles, breaking some of them. Responding officers located a 29-year-old Milwaukee man in the 3100 Block of South Chicago Avenue who admitted to taking the liquor bottles. He was issued a citation for Retail Theft.
