

SOUTH MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WEEKLY CRIME SUMMARY *5/06/19 – 5/12/19*

(This report does not include every call for service but rather serves as a highlight of notable calls where a report was filed.)



The past week the South Milwaukee Police Department responded to **316** calls for service.

DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

Officers were dispatched to a report of a male and female arguing in the 3700 Block of South Chicago Avenue on May 9th and upon arrival spoke with a 25-year-old South Milwaukee woman and a 29-year-old South Milwaukee man. The two were involved in a verbal argument and the woman left the area. Approximately two and a half hours later, officers returned to the area for a report of an individual breaking a window and once again spoke with the man. He admitted to breaking the window and was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. A charge of Criminal Damage to Property-Domestic Violence Related was issued against the man by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Officers were dispatched to a report of a group of people arguing in the 400 Block of Marion Avenue on May 10th where one of the individuals involved displayed a weapon before recklessly leaving the scene in a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle in the 1400 Block of Marquette Avenue and conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 25-year-old South Milwaukee man, admitted to having a BB gun in the trunk of the vehicle. He was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Disorderly Conduct-Use of a Dangerous Weapon.

Officers were dispatched to a report of individuals fighting in the 1200 Block of Memorial Drive on May 7th. Officers spoke with a 24-year-old South Milwaukee woman who stated she punched a 25-year-old South Milwaukee man during an argument. The man had a visible injury but denied medical attention. The woman was arrested and referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Domestic Violence Battery.

Officers were dispatched to a report of an intoxicated individual refusing to leave a residence in the 500 Block of Badger Avenue on May 12th. Upon arrival, they spoke with a 50-year-old South Milwaukee woman who showed signs of impairment. It was discovered the woman was out on a signature bond from a prior OWI-4th Offense violation and a condition of her bail was she was not to consume alcohol. She was arrested and taken to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility before being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on a charge of Bail Jumping.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED

Officers were dispatched to report of a vehicle striking a tree near the Oak Creek Parkway and Mill Road on May 9th. Upon arrival, the driver, a 27-year-old South Milwaukee woman, showed signs of impairment. She was arrested and taken to the hospital by South Milwaukee Fire Department personnel before being transported to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. She was later charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense.
