

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS BY HOMEOWNER

South Milwaukee Municipal Code Section 17.13 allows the owner/occupant of a single family dwelling who has occupied the dwelling for at least one (1) year to perform electrical installation upon such premise.

An electrical permit must be obtained and inspections called for.

The electrical installation shall be performed by the owner/occupant only. No one else shall be permitted to cause such installation unless licensed by the City of South Milwaukee as an electrical contractor. Installation by anyone else shall be cause for legal action to be taken by the City of South Milwaukee.

Per South Milwaukee Municipal Code Section 17.13 (4)(i)&(ii) this affidavit does not allow owners to perform the following work:

- **Wiring a service or feeder**
- **Circuit of a voltage greater than 110 volts**
- **Hot tubs, pools, central air and electric water heater**

The above work must be performed by a licensed electrician.

I feel I am knowledgeable enough to properly install the electrical wiring I have taken a permit out for. It will be installed according to the Standards of Wisconsin Administrative Code & SPS 316 in a safe and workmanship like manner.
