

Mill Road Bridge over Oak Creek PROJECT STARTING JUNE 2022

On Monday, June 6, 2022, road construction will begin on the Mill Road bridge between Milwaukee Avenue and Oak Creek Parkway. The existing Mill Road bridge, over Oak Creek, will be rehabilitated. Work performed will primarily consist of grading, HMA pavement, pavement marking, rail repainting, slope repair, replacing limestone masonry endwall, salvage and replace limestone fascia blocks, tuckpointing, and concrete curb and gutter. Work is anticipated to be completed by fall 2022. Mill Road will be closed to traffic between Milwaukee Avenue and Oak Creek Parkway including vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians and detoured until the major construction operations are completed and the bridge repairs and HMA pavement are completed. The detour will be signed as shown on this flyer.

This project is sponsored by the Milwaukee County Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT).


