



In an effort to assist the citizens of South Milwaukee with clean-up from the storm on Monday night (June 13, 2022), the following adjustments to our standard operating procedures will be made. This special allowance will remain in effect until June 30, 2022 to allow residents time to do their clean-up from the storm.

Tree Damage

- Street Department crews will be spending the next several days / weeks driving up and down all neighborhoods and picking up tree damage.
 - **City owned tree:**
 - ◆ Right of way, four feet from the curb. No charge for storm damage. Please call (414) 768-8075 to report tree damage.
 - **Private property tree:**
 - ◆ Branch piles the size of a car or smaller: Free / no phone call needed. Due to the amount of debris city wide, we ask for your patience as we will address each pile as soon as possible.
 - ◆ Branch piles larger than the size of a car: \$20 for each car size increment. Please call (414) 768-8075 to arrange for a pickup: Payment will have to be received before pickup. Due to large call volume, same day or next day service may not be possible.
 - ◆ Logs: All tree logs will require a \$100 loader fee. Please call (414) 768-8075 to arrange a loader pickup.
 - **Self-Deposit Station:**
 - ◆ All storm related damage: The \$3.00 per visit fee will be waived for storm damage items only: Storm damage items plus other miscellaneous items will still be charged the \$3.00 per visit fee.
