Shredding - Drive-thru. Volunteers will be removing material to be shredded from your vehicle. So, please stay in your vehicle.

Electronics Recycling - The following will be accepted:

- Computer Equipment** - CPUs, Towers, Laptops, Mainframe Computers, Hard Drives, Peripherals, Servers, Routers, Keyboards, Mice, Monitors (2005 and newer), Power Supplies, and Modems.
- Office Equipment** - Printers, Fax Machines, Overhead Projectors, Copiers, Scanners, Electronic Typewriters, Transparency Makers.
- Communications Equipment** - Two-Way Radios, Telephones, Satellite Dishes, Pagers, PDAs, Transmitters, Receivers, Answering Machines.
- Security Electronic Devices** - Cameras, DVRs, Tape Recorders, CCTV Monitors(2005 and newer).
- Personal Electronics** - CD Player Equipment, Tape Players, VCRs, iPods, and MP3 players, and Remote Controls.
- Small Electronics** - Bread Makers, Electric Mixers, Hair Dryers, and Curling Irons.

(TVs and CRT monitors will NOT be accepted at the Grobschmidt Senior Center parking lot event.)
