

Mill Road Bridge over Oak Creek

PROJECT UPDATE

May 2023

Construction has resumed on the Mill Road Bridge over Oak Creek. In addition to weather and environmental constraints, the scope of work has been expanded to preserve and restore the historic appearance near the dam. New limestone fascia will be installed on the bridge followed by replacing sections of the east retaining wall and placing new stepped flagstones on the west side that were removed during the spandrel wall replacement.

Remaining work also includes slope repair, concrete surface and crack repair, railing repainting, storm sewer, concrete sidewalk, concrete curb and gutter, HMA pavement, and restoration. Mill Road will be repaved from Oak Creek Parkway to Milwaukee Avenue in coordination with the City of South Milwaukee. Construction is anticipated to be completed and Mill Road open to traffic by mid-summer 2023.

Mill Road will remain closed to traffic between Milwaukee Avenue and Oak Creek Parkway. Vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian detours remain in place.

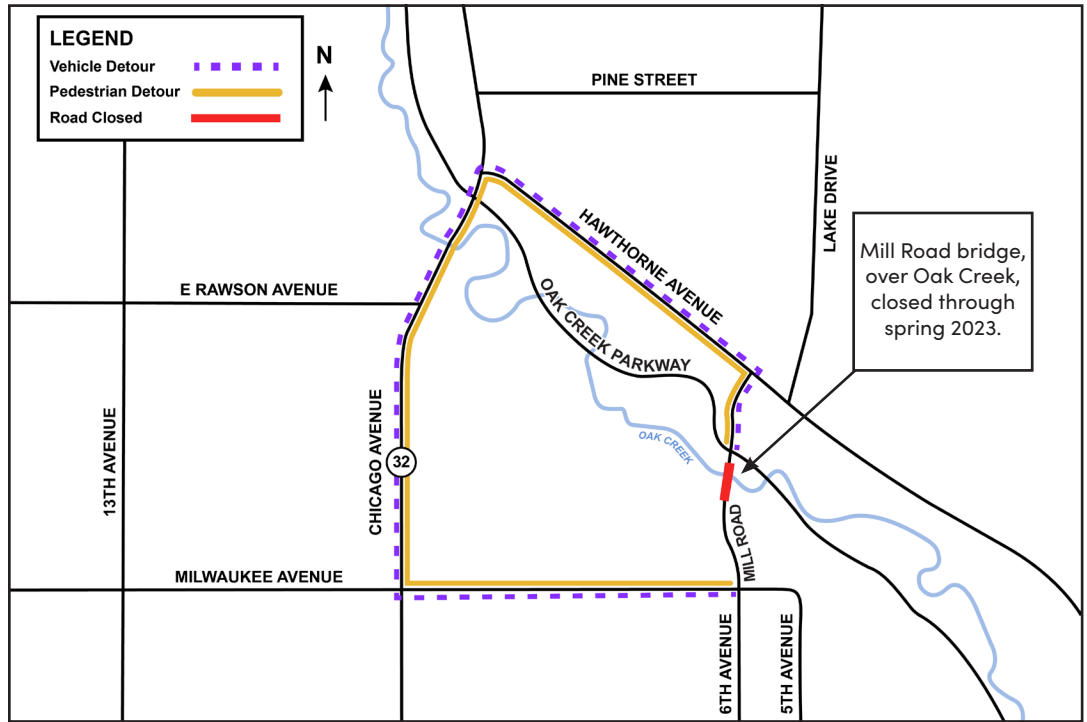
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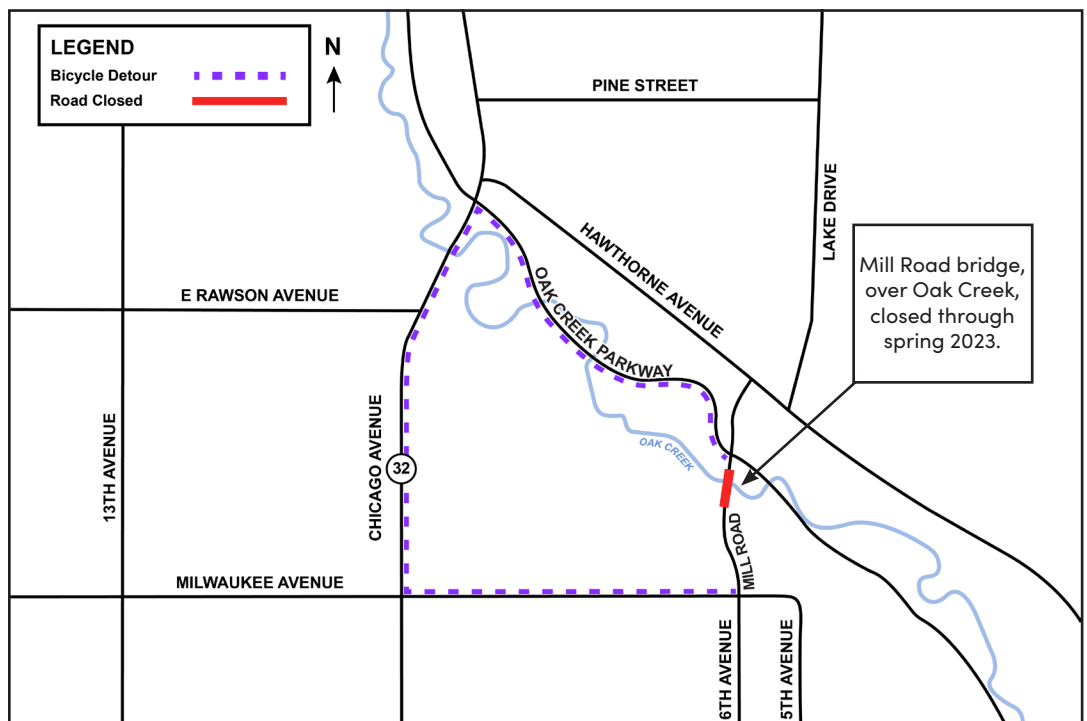
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Vehicle and Pedestrian Detour
