 <b>PAPER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Newspapers &amp; inserts</li> <li>• Magazines &amp; books</li> <li>• Junk mail &amp; envelopes</li> <li>• Phone books &amp; catalogs</li> <li>• Office paper (any color)</li> <li>• Corrugated cardboard</li> <li>• Paper grocery bags</li> <li>• Non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, soda pack boxes)</li> <li>• Frozen food boxes</li> <li>• Dairy carton boxes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tissue products and paper towels</li> <li>• Paper contaminated with food residue or other debris</li> <li>• Pizza boxes or carry out food wrappers</li> </ul>
 <b>GLASS</b>	<p>Clear, green, brown, and tinted glass. Please rinse and remove lids and caps.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any color glass bottles, jugs, or jars</li> <li>• Glass beverage &amp; glass food containers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ceramic items (dishes, vases, cups)</li> <li>• Drinking glasses or crystal</li> <li>• Light bulbs</li> <li>• Window or auto glass</li> </ul>
 <b>PLASTIC</b>	<p>Containers labeled 1, 2, and 5, on the bottom. Please rinse and remove lids and caps. Not necessary to remove paper labels.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Soda bottles</li> <li>• Milk &amp; water jugs</li> <li>• Laundry bottles</li> <li>• Shampoo, conditioner, lotion, and cosmetic bottles</li> <li>• Dairy tubs (butter, margarine, yogurt, sour cream)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Motor oil &amp; Antifreeze bottles</li> <li>• Styrofoam or microwave containers</li> <li>• Plastic toys, flower pots/garden plastics</li> <li>• Pesticide or herbicide containers</li> <li>• Medical supplies</li> <li>• Plastic bags</li> </ul>
 <b>CANS</b>	<p>Please rinse all cans. No necessary to remove paper labels.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All aluminum cans</li> <li>• All steel or bi-metal cans</li> <li>• Metal lids &amp; bottle caps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aluminum foil &amp; pie tins</li> <li>• Paint cans &amp; aerosol cans</li> <li>• Car parts, nails, and screws</li> <li>• Pots and pans</li> <li>• Gasoline cans and scrap metal</li> </ul>
