Recap: Key Highlights from the Latest Common Council Meeting

February 6, 2024 - Common Council Meeting

Recapping the Recent Common Council Meeting: A Summary of Decisions and Discussions

- Approved the City's 2024/2025 Capital Improvement Program in the amount of \$8,966,900 for infrastructure projects and equipment expected to last at least 10 years.
- Directed the City Attorney to draft a charter ordinance amendment to stagger aldermanic terms, beginning with the 2027 aldermanic elections.
- The Common Council decided not to explore term limits for South Milwaukee elected officials.
- Acknowledged receipt of \$75,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from Milwaukee County for Senior Center services and the City's code enforcement program.
- Approved an updated leadership structure for the Street Department.
- Mayor Shelenske presented a proclamation to Ben Tyjeski, co-author of [Carl Bergmans and the Continental Faience & Tile Co.](#)

- Authorizing emergency replacement of the Street Department Municipal Building boiler unit.
