### March 19, 2024 - Common Council Meeting

Recapping the Recent Common Council Meeting: A Summary of Decisions and Discussions

- Update provided on [South Milwaukee's Earth Day](#) event on Saturday, April 20th from 9:00 am - noon.
- Presentation of a painting donated to the City of South Milwaukee from American Legion Post 27.
- Approved a modified charter ordinance pertaining to staggered aldermanic elections.
- Approved an ordinance to permit certain plantings within the "curb lawn" right-of-way.
- Water/Wastewater Superintendent provided an update on South Milwaukee's Lead Service Line replacement project. Learn more about our [Lead Service Line Replacement](#) project.
- Approved an amendment to Ordinance No. 2249 on Lead Service Line replacements.

### April 3, 2024 - Special Common Council Meeting

Recapping the Recent Common Council Meeting: A Summary of Decisions and Discussions

- Reminder provided on [South Milwaukee's Earth Day](#) event on Saturday, April 20th from 9:00 am - noon. A City-wide Cleanup event was added; begin at City Hall to pickup litter at several locations around South Milwaukee before finishing up with complimentary snacks at City Hall at noon.
- Proclamation honoring Alderperson Ramon Navarro's dedicated service to the City of South Milwaukee.
- A Public Hearing was held on a proposed official map amendment ordinance for Monroe Court Subdivision and public road extension at Monroe Avenue and 7th Avenue.
- Approved an amendment to Ordinance No. 2250 to fix an establish the amount of salaries to be paid to the Distributions and Collections Project Coordinator, Distributions and Collections Lead, and Administrative Assistant in the Water/Wastewater Department.
- Approved a Conditional Use Permit to convert a two-family to a three-family dwelling at 912 Monroe Avenue.
- Approved a Conditional Use Permit to allow for a gas station at 1715 10th Avenue.
- Approved an ordinance to amend the City of South Milwaukee Official Map for Monroe Court Subdivision at 2001 7th Avenue.
- Approved a resolution approving the final plat for Monroe Court Subdivision.
- Approved a resolution supporting the 128th Air Refueling Wing of Wisconsin Air National Guard to acquire the KC-46A Pegasus at General Mitchell Air National Guard Base.
- Approved the addition of six picnic tables around the perimeter of the grass area at the Bucyrus Commons.
- Considered and decided not to take action on a request to exempt non-profit organizations from paying special event permit fees.
