

BALLOT ACCESS CHECKLIST FOR MUNICIPAL CANDIDATES

Each of the following forms must be completed and filed on time by candidates for municipal office for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot for the spring election.

Complete and submit a [**Campaign Registration Statement**](#) (Form CF-1) to the filing officer no later than **5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2024**.

All candidates should file a campaign registration statement or amended statement before circulating nomination papers. A current form must be filed with the filing officer no later than January 2, 2024, or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot.

Must complete sections:

A. **General Information** A1- A29 B. **Candidate Committee** B1- B12 G. **Certification** G1- G6

Complete and submit a [**Declaration of Candidacy**](#) (Form EL-162) to the filing officer no later than **5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2024** This original document form must be filed no later than January 2, 2024, or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot.

Circulate and submit the [**Nomination Paper for Nonpartisan Office**](#) (Form EL-169) to the filing officer. For the **EL-169 form** Original nomination papers (no photocopies, faxes, or emailed documents) must be received by the City Clerk's Office no later than **5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2024**, or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. Nomination papers **may not be circulated before December 1, 2023**.

When obtaining signatures, the date of signing must be completed.

All offices are 3-year terms.

The number of signatures required is as follows:

- **Citywide offices** (Mayor, Judge) **50 – 100 signatures**
- **Alderperson** **20 - 40 signatures**

Spring Primary will be held on Tuesday, February 20, 2024 (if needed)

Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2024.
